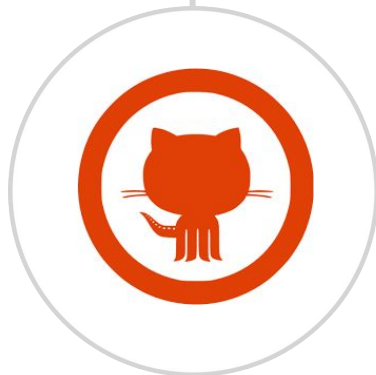
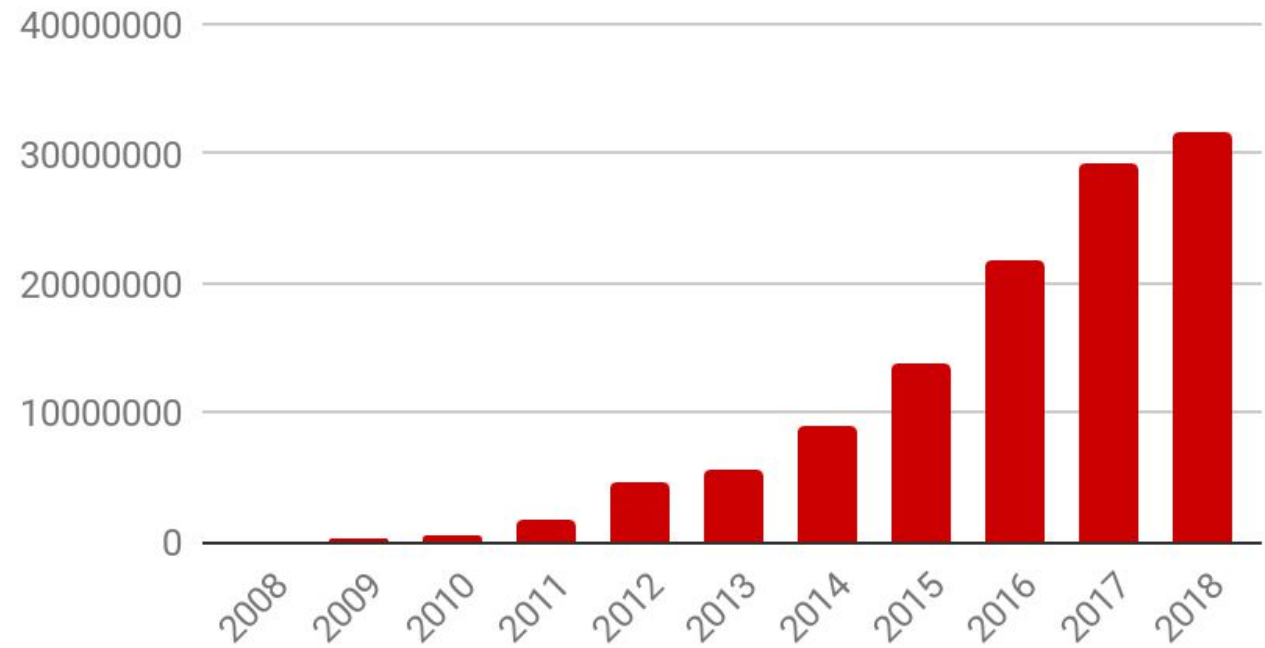
Software Development in the Open

Open Source through the Lens of GitHub

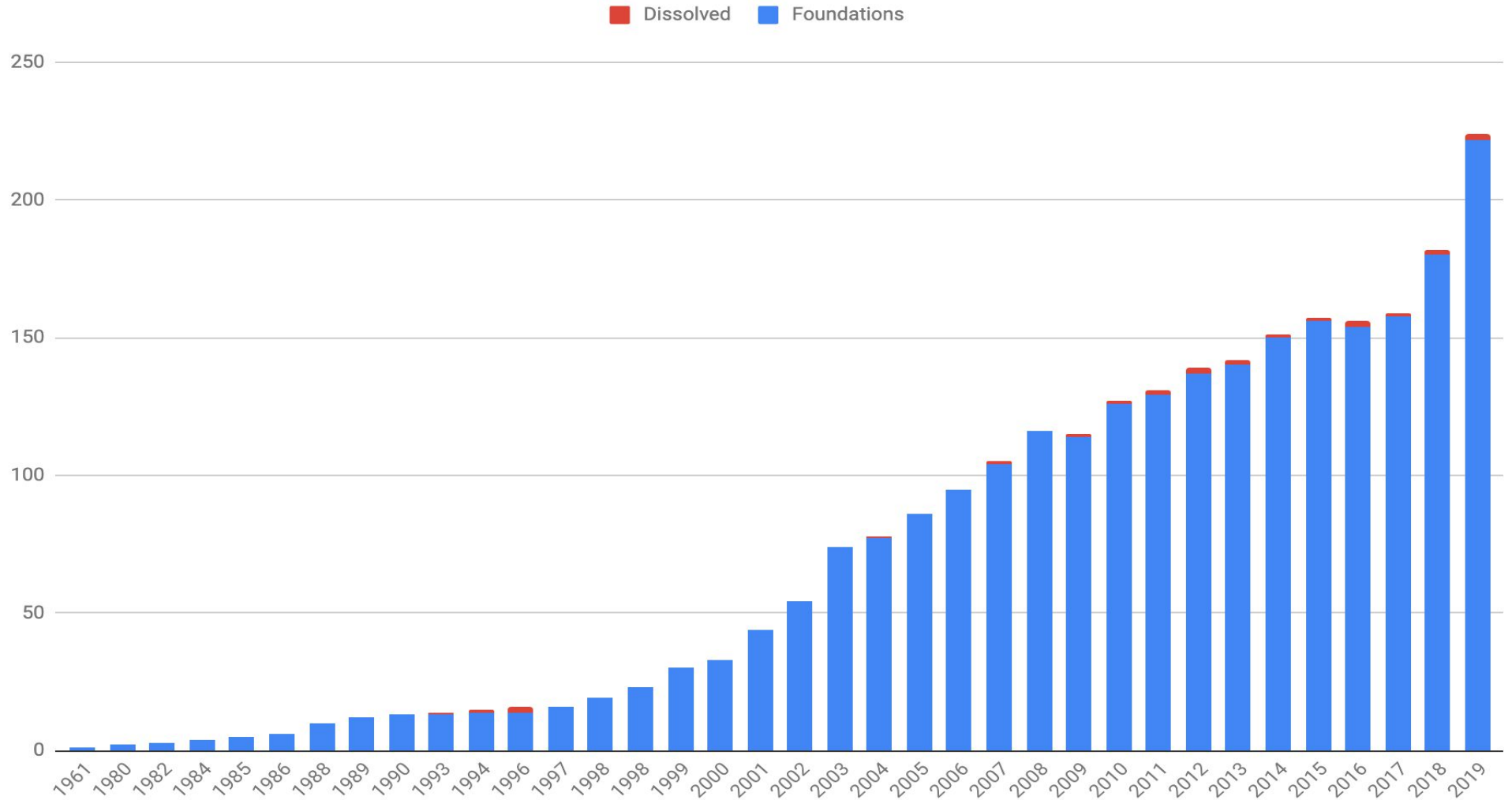
Total Active Issues



Total Active Repositories

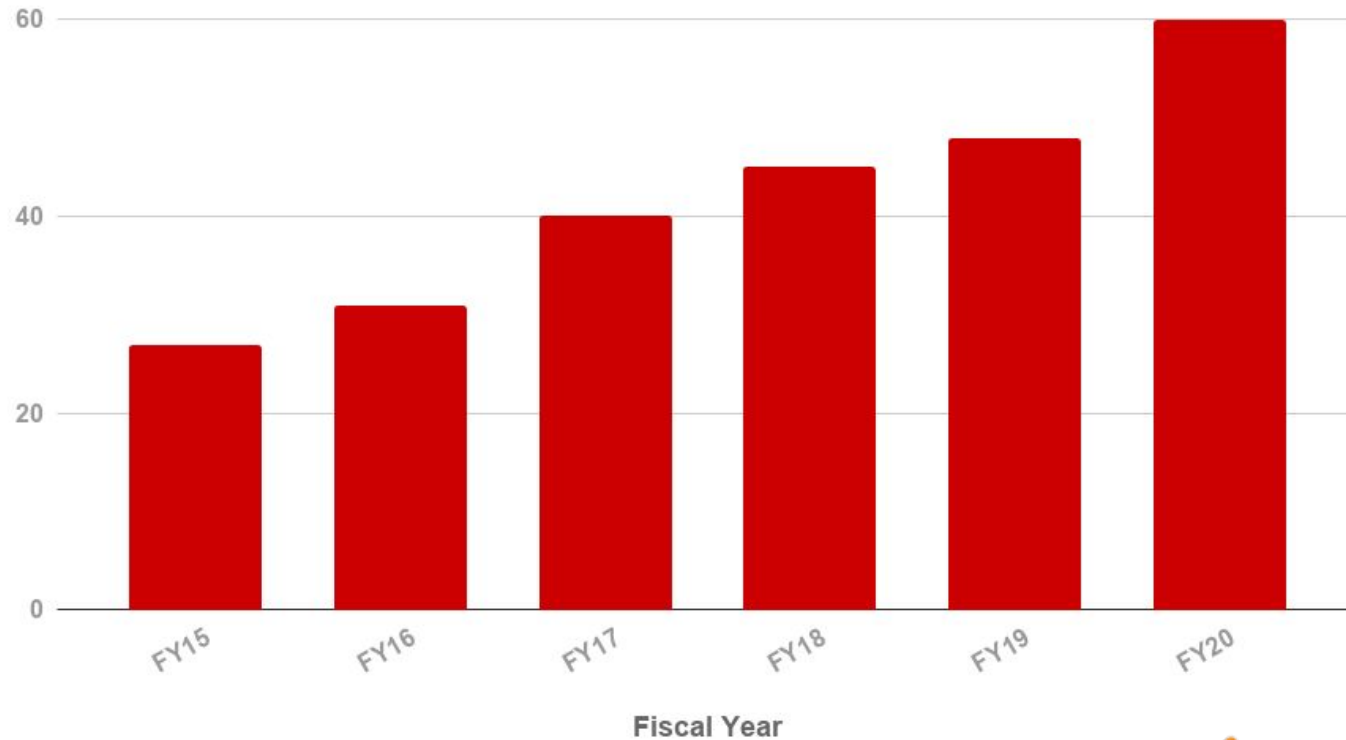


The Rise of Open Source Software Foundations

Trend two: Building organizational competencies

InnerSource is the use of open source software development best practices and the establishment of an open source-like culture within organizations.

The organization may still develop proprietary software, but internally opens up its development.

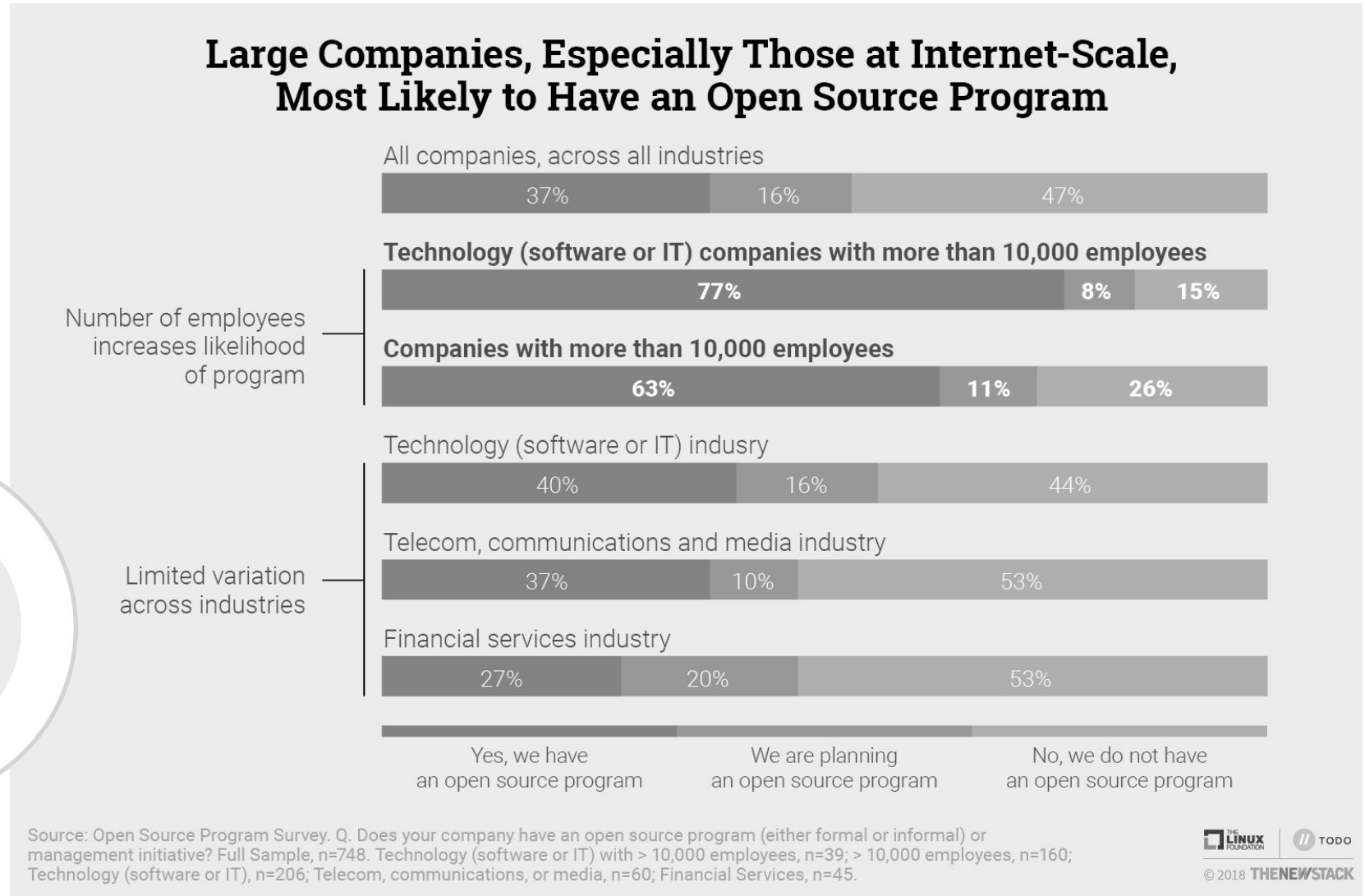
The term was coined in 2000.

- Within the safety of company firewalls; the benefit of experimenting with open culture and software development practices.
- An effective approach to building organizational capacity
- Positive impact on company culture
- Opportunity to evaluate open source development
- May serve as a bridge to full open source

Trend three: Deeper customer engagement in upstream projects

Build/Buy/Both

Deepening the rewards from open source via direct participation

Rapport and credibility: Working on open source projects attracts top notch talent.

Influence: Working in the upstream markedly increases the opportunity to influence project features important to an organization.

Depth of understanding of technology: Invaluable insight and access to the community of developers producing the software delivers clear benefits.

Sustained technology lifecycle: Contributions help ensure the viability of the project the company depends upon.

Case Study: Amadeus innovates customer service with Red Hat

Business Challenge: Amadeus, a travel technology company, needed a state-of-the-art platform to the increasingly complex demands of their customers; for an on-site solution that mitigated security risks and could meet diverse regulatory requirements.

Solution: Amadeus' team worked with the OpenShift and Red Hat Enterprise Linux engineering teams to create a private cloud-based application platform, to the specifications of a unique travel industry customer.

Related projects: The joint effort resulted in projects focused on orchestrating middleware, monitoring the platform, and creating an engaging developer experience.

Outcomes:


- Decreased system latency and improved platform availability
- Streamlined operations through automation
- Reduced time to market for new applications
- Results: open source and the global future
