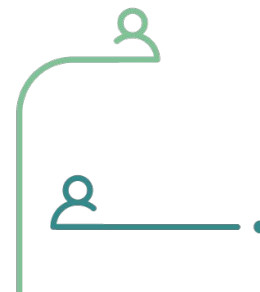


# Initial Program Goals

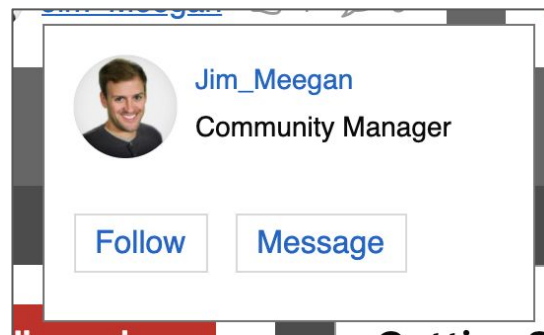
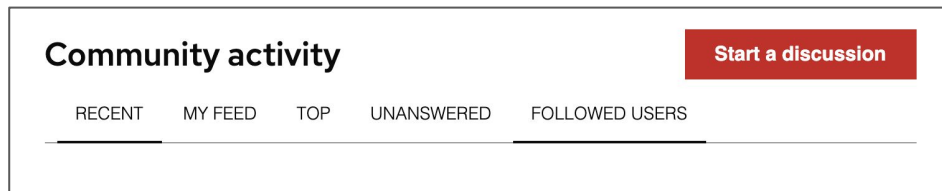

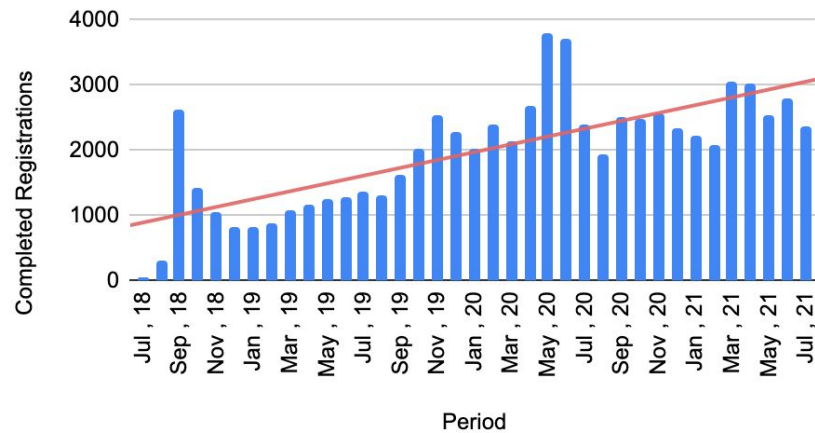
