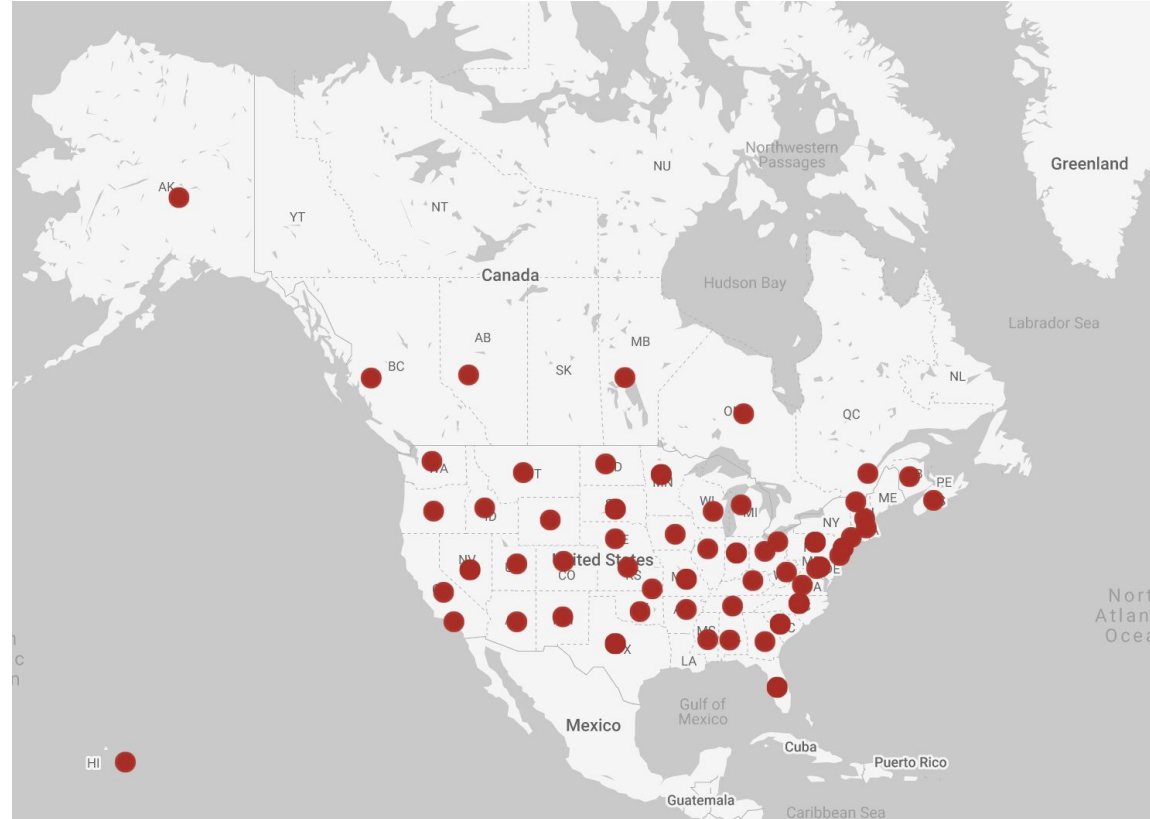



Students can create and manage their profile within the network. Recruiters can search for specific skillsets and reach out to students through the imbedded messaging center.

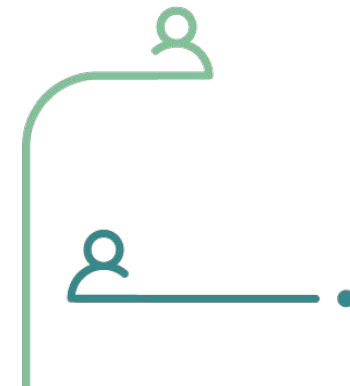
